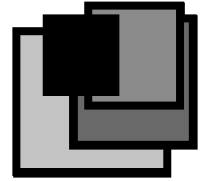

## Mwanza International School Fees for 2024/25

Content reviewed: July 2024

International education is inevitably expensive, if the school is to provide good facilities and internationally qualified teachers. However, it is our aim to make the fees as affordable as possible. The fees are made up of two separate parts, details of which are outlined below.

**1. Tuition Fees (per term):** These fees depend on the year group of the child:

<b>Pre-School</b>	<b>Tsh 1,195,000</b>
(Pre-School optional afternoon session)	Tsh 595,000
<b>Key Stage One (Reception, Year 1 &amp; 2)</b>	<b>Tsh 2,995,000</b>
<b>Key Stage Two (Year 3, 4, 5 &amp; 6)</b>	<b>Tsh 3,195,000</b>
<b>Key Stage Three (Year 7, 8 &amp; 9)</b>	<b>Tsh 4,195,000</b>
<b>Key Stage Four (Years 10 and 11 - GCSE)</b>	<b>Tsh 5,295,000</b>

Tuition Fees are paid per term (3 terms). The fees cover all lessons, use of school facilities and books.

Fees do not cover uniform, food, transport, or the cost of school trips.

There is a **10% discount** for a second and subsequent children of same parents. here is a **5% discount** for the year's fees where they are paid in full by the first day of term.

Approximate age for each key stage is given below; however, age is not the only factor in deciding the best year group for a particular child. Please see the admissions section of our website for more information.

Pre-School: 3-4 years old

Key Stage 1: 4-7 years old

Key Stage 2: 7-11 years old

Key Stage 3: 11-14 years old

Key Stage 4: 14-16 years old

## 2. Additional Fees for New Parents:

### The Enrolment Fee

This is paid once only, at the beginning of the child's time in the school. It is a contribution to the development of the school. The enrolment fee is lower for Secondary students in recognition that they will spend less time studying at the school. It is also waived for the child's first term in Secondary, to ensure that they are settling in well. If they continue onto the next term the full enrolment fee is then payable.

**Primary Enrolment Fee:** Tsh **1,500,000**

**Primary Enrolment Fee for siblings:** Tsh **1,000,000**

**Secondary Enrolment Fee (payable in second term only):** Tsh **750,000**

**Secondary Enrolment Fee for siblings (payable in second term only):** Tsh **500,000**

**Returnable Deposit:** Tsh **1,395,000**

This is paid once only, when the child starts school. It is otherwise known as 'Caution Money' and is held against damage to, or loss of, property or non-payment of fees. The deposit is returned when the child leaves school, **provided at least half a term's notice is given** and no money is owed to the school.
